

## Online First Responder Course

The goal of the First Responder Course is to provide a foundation in prehospital care of sick or injured patients. The course meets all National Registry mandatory core content and Colorado Division of Fire Safety requirements. A certificate of course completion will be granted upon successful completion of all course requirements. The course has several components: 1) online, for chapter work, assignments, and exams; 2) face-to-face class time for review, Q/A, and skills; 3) online chat time, with virtual classes scheduled throughout the course.
