

Emergency Medical Technician – Basic (EMT-B)

The HealthONE EMS Department, in partnership with Arapahoe Community College, offers the EMT-Basic course, consisting of a minimum of 180 hours of classroom and practical sessions at least 44 hours of clinical rotations in the hospital and ambulance settings (outside of regular classroom time). The course is designed to meet the requirements of the Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section of the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division, CDPHE. This course prepares the student for the National Registry exam and Colorado State EMT-Basic certification.
