

EMT-Paramedic

HealthONE EMS, in partnership with Arapahoe Community College, offers the EMT-Paramedic course. The course consists of a minimum of 436 hours of classroom and practical sessions and 650 hours of clinical and field experience. The course is designed to prepare the student for the National Registry examination. The program may be completed in 6 or 12 months. This course is web enhanced. In addition to classroom time some course work will be completed online. Students must have internet access, preferably with a high speed connection.

Prerequisites:

- Current EMT-B certification with a minimum of one year field experience
- High school graduate (submit high school and/or college transcripts)
- Proof of hepatitis B vaccination, tetanus, chickenpox, and MMR vaccinations
- Copy of criminal background investigation (CBI) report (within 6 months prior to class)
- Successful completion of basic dysrhythmia (Basic EKG) course or equivalent
- Successful completion of IV Approval course or equivalent
 - Current CPR card (must be a BCLS course approved by Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section of the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division, CDPHE)
 - Signed Statement of Receipt form enclosed in the information packets
 - Anatomy and Physiology (4 credit hours) Bio 106 is required as a minimum for the certificate track
 - One year college level Anatomy and Physiology (8 credit hours). Bio 201 and 202 is required for the Associates Degree track.
 - Passing scores on all pretests
- Successful completion of oral interview
- Two (2) written employer references
- \$50 non-refundable application fee (Paid to HealthONE EMS)
- \$25 Testing Fee (Paid to Arapahoe Community College)
- Internet access

Tuition:

\$6,501.40 (paid to Arapahoe Community College, subject to change without notification, and based on Colorado State Residency Requirement. Tuition listed reflects discount after student has applied for the College Opportunity Fund at www.collegeincolorado.org. The guideline to qualify for Colorado residency status is 12 months of continuous physical presence in Colorado at the time of course registration.) Revised by ACC June 2008.
