

Emergency Medical Technician – Basic (EMT-B)

North Suburban Medical Center's EMS Department, in partnership with Red Rocks Community College, offers the EMT-Basic course, consisting of a minimum of 144 hours of classroom and practical sessions and 66 hours of clinical rotations in the hospital and ambulance settings (outside of regular classroom time). The course is designed to meet the requirements of the Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section of the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division, CDPHE. This course prepares the student for the National Registry exam and Colorado State EMT-Basic certification.

- **Copy of current CPR card. Must be a CPR course approved by the Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section of the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division, CDPHE (303-692-2980)**
- **Physician Authorization form from application packet completed.**

- **Copy of high school diploma or GED**
