

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

The HealthONE EMS Department, in partnership with Arapahoe Community College, offers the EMT course, consisting of a minimum of 180 hours of classroom and practical sessions at least 44 hours of clinical rotations in the hospital and ambulance settings (outside of regular classroom time). The course is designed to meet the requirements of the Emergency Medical and Trauma Services Section of the Health Facilities and Emergency Medical Services Division, CDPHE. This course prepares the student for the National Registry exam and Colorado State EMT certification.

- Completed HealthONE application including course dates
- 18 years of age by first day of class (submit copy of birth certificate or driver's license)
- Proof of: first dose of hepatitis B vaccination, tetanus, chickenpox, MMR vaccines, and PPD vaccines
- Proof of seasonal flu vaccine for classes running during flu season (early Fall to late Spring of the following year)
- Copy of current AHA BLS for the Healthcare Provider card.
- Copy of Criminal Background Investigation (CBI) report
- Signed Statement of Receipt (from the information packet)
- Successful completion of Computer Placement Test (administered at ACC) or copy of Bachelor's degree
- Completed Arapahoe Community College application sent to ACC (call 303-797-4ACC for information)

- Two (2) written employer references
