

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) Provider

This course is intended for health care providers who are responsible for the well being of infants and children. The course is designed to provide participants with the information needed to recognize infants and children at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest, strategies to prevent arrest and skills needed to resuscitate and stabilize those in respiratory failure, shock, or cardiopulmonary arrest. The course is based on the 2010 AHA Guidelines.

Intended audience includes Pediatricians, emergency physicians, family physicians, PA's, nurses, nurse practitioners, paramedics, respiratory therapists, and other healthcare providers who initiate and direct advanced life support in pediatric emergencies.
