



Amusement Park Safety

Use Common Sense

- Obey all verbal and posted rules and instructions
- Keep all body parts in the ride at all times
- Remain securely restrained and use grab bars
- If the ride stops unexpectedly, remain seated and wait for instruction from the ride operator
- Do not ride if under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- Hold tight and keep eyes facing forward to avoid neck injuries
- Walk, never run
- Watch your step getting on or off rides
- If a ride looks poorly maintained, do not board

Kids and Rides

- Always supervise your children and never leave them unattended
- Have your child watch the ride with you before they board; if they are afraid of the ride they may try to get off the ride while it is moving

- Read rules and warnings aloud and make sure they understand
- Tell your child to hold on tight with both hands and use the seatbelts if they are part of the ride
- Always obey age, weight, and height restrictions
- Amusement rides are not childproof nor child safe
Use good judgment in what you allow your child to ride

Dress Appropriately

- Wear closed toe shoes that are secured on your feet
- Avoid wearing anything that may get caught in machinery like drawstrings or dangling jewelry
- Stow loose items such as hats and sunglasses
- Long hair should be tied back
